- Extended hours on Wednesdays until 7 p.m.

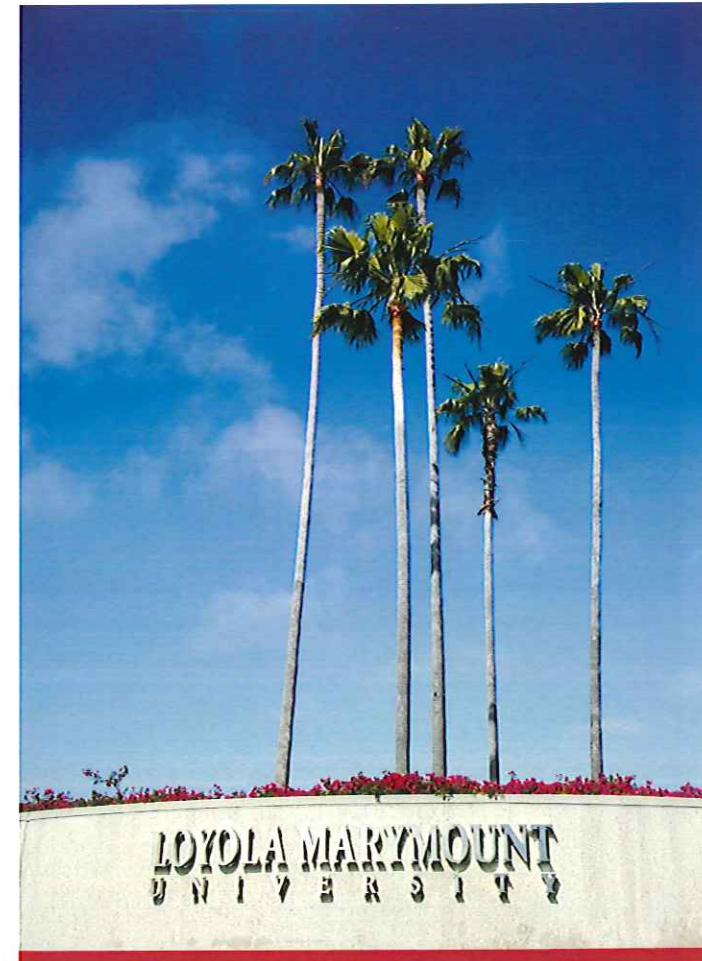

STUDENT HEALTH SERVICES OFFERS A WIDE RANGE OF PRIMARY HEALTH CARE SERVICES:

- Treatment for illnesses, injuries and preventive care
- Women's health services
- Dermatological care
- Immunizations and allergy shots
- Laboratory and X-ray services
- Health education and wellness programs

ELIGIBILITY

- Health services are available to all students enrolled in six units or more.

COST

- Students are charged for prescribed medications, lab work, X-rays, and necessary medical supplies.
- Graduate and law students pay \$50 per semester when they access Student Health Services.
- Charges are billed directly to the student's account.

HEALTH INSURANCE

- LMU requires that all full-time undergraduate and graduate students be covered by health insurance in case of accidents, hospitalizations and special conditions requiring care outside of Student Health Services. Students without health insurance coverage are required to purchase the university-endorsed combined accident and sickness health insurance plan through Aetna Student Health.
